COVID-19 WAIVER

NOTICE: ANYONE THAT ATTENDS A CLASS OR IS A GUARDIAN OR GUEST OF SOMEONE ATTENDING A CLASS HOSTED BY THE DOG OBEDIENCE CLUB OF HOLLYWOOD, INC. ("DOCOH") MUST SIGN THIS FORM; NO EXCEPTIONS. IF YOU ARE AT THE DAVIE ARENA ON THE BERGERON RODEO GROUNDS, THIS FORM MUST BE ON FILE WITH THE CLUB.

I fully attest to the best of my knowledge that I do not have COVID-19 at the time of attending a class, have not exhibited any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 in the 14 days preceding attendance of a class nor have I traveled out of the State during that 14-day time period. I confirm that, to my knowledge, I have not been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 14 days of attending a class. If I previously had a documented case of COVID-19, I understand that I must submit a physician's note of negative status in order to attend any training classes. Finally, I understand and agree that if, at any time while taking a training class offered by DOCOH or within 14 days of taking any class, I test positive for COVID-19, I shall contact my DOCOH Class instructor immediately to inform him or her of my positive status.

I acknowledge and agree that I am attending or participating in a class hosted by the Dog Obedience Club of Hollywood entirely at my own risk and take full responsibility for my health and safety at all times. I will follow all CDC, Federal, State, County and local rules, requirements, procedures and guidelines as well as DOCOH's guidelines and procedures regarding COVID-19 (collectively, the "COVID Rules") that are in place at the time of any class I attend in order to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading the virus. I further understand and agree that if I do not follow any of these COVID Rules, I will be asked to leave the class and will not be eligible for any refund.

I fully submit that DOCOH, and its Officers, Board of Directors, any workers or volunteers (collectively, the "Club Representatives") are in no way liable for any present or future COVID-19 exposure incurred at any time by any person, in attendance or not in attendance, during or after any class, and hereby waive all rights to file any action against DOCOH and the Club Representatives if I am exposed to COVID-19.

DOG OBEDIENCE CLUB OF HOLLYWOOD
COVID-19 GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES
Effective as of July 1, 2020; Revised as of May 1, 2021

This document shall serve as the Dog Obedience Club of Hollywood's ("DOCOH") guidelines and procedures to hold Agility and Obedience training classes in the Davie Arena at the Bergeron Rodeo Grounds (the "Arena"). Implementing these guidelines will require a coordinated effort among our teachers, Club members, students and guests. The health and safety of our local dog community is our primary concern. If additional guidelines, recommendations, or procedures are necessary, DOCOH will update and distribute this document in a timely manner.

The Coronavirus pandemic has been an ongoing developing situation since March 2020. DOCOH encourages its members, attendees, and guests to monitor publicly available information and to always follow State and local health guidelines and mandates. The information contained in these guidelines is provided for informational purposes only for participants in DOCOH's weekly training classes and events and should not be construed as legal advice on any subject matter.

Training Classes

1. Teachers, Club members, all training class participants and guests are required to follow State and local guidelines that are applicable to the Arena, regardless of an individual's vaccination status, including:

- practicing social distancing consistent with current guidelines
- avoid congregating after class is over
- wearing masks at all times, except when actively running in an Agility class, unless health protocols dictate otherwise (all attendees shall provide their own masks).

2. No attendee shall have exhibited signs or symptoms of COVID-19 in the 14 days preceding attendance at the Arena. If a person has had a documented case of COVID-19, a physician's note of negative status is needed in order to attend any training sessions. No attendee shall have traveled out of the State for 14 days prior to attending any training sessions. If an attendee, at any time while taking a training class offered by DOCOH or within 14 days of taking any class, tests positive for COVID-19, they shall contact their class instructor immediately to inform them of their positive status. All attendees shall execute and deliver a Waiver to this effect.

3. The Club will provide hand sanitizer for attendees' use upon entry to the Arena and near class areas. If an attendee chooses to wear disposable (or washable) gloves, they must be disposed of properly.

4. Attendees shall avoid touching their face, shaking hands, and hugging other individuals and shall sneeze or cough into a tissue or inside of their elbow. Attendees shall avoid touching dogs that are not their own. Teachers may touch dogs as needed for assistance during a class, but only with a mask on.

5. Until such time as restrictions are eased and communicated to the Club by the Town of Davie, the Club will not allow access to the common use areas (picnic tables/concession areas), and the Arena bathrooms will be closed until further notice. All attendees are asked to please plan accordingly.

6. All attendees are asked to park with increased distance between vehicles as much as possible.

7. Anyone wishing to take a scheduled class offered by the Club shall go to the Club's website to register and pre-pay electronically. The Club shall not offer drop-in classes until such time as restrictions are eased. Once drop-in classes start, if students have not prepaid electronically, they must bring exact change in an envelope or pay onsite electronically.

8. No Training Class grouping will be larger than 10 individuals, excluding DOCOH instructors. Until such time as restrictions are eased and communicated to the Club by the Town of Davie, all guests will be asked to keep their distance from the training group and bring their own chairs.

9. Training Class locations will be on the clay surface under cover in separate groups at the north and south end of the Arena, on the blacktop area by the bathroom building, and on the blacktop area in the southwest corner of the Arena property.

10. The Club shall post a current copy of these guidelines and procedures on the Club's website. The Obedience and Agility Training Directors shall distribute these guidelines to all instructors and post a copy in visible spaces. Instructors shall review these guidelines and procedures with class attendees and guests at each class session and distribute copies via e-mail upon initial registration.

11. All attendees are expected to follow these guidelines, as may be amended from time to time; those who do not will be asked to leave the premises immediately and shall not be eligible for a refund of registration fees paid.
