

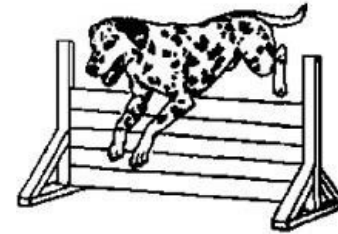

## **ENTRY FEES**

### **REGULAR & OPTIONAL TITLING OBEDIENCE CLASSES AND RALLY CLASSES**

Entries Close: 6:00 PM Wednesday, September 20, 2023 at the Secretary's office, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or altered.

Entry fee shall be \$25.00 per dog per trial. A discounted entry fee of \$15.00 will apply for each additional entry of the SAME DOG in the SAME Obedience or Rally Trial.

Obedience & Rally Entry fees include the following event recording fees, payable to the AKC: \$3.50 for the first entry of each dog and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog.

Make checks payable to: DOCOH.

Entry fees will be accepted via PayPal **IF** the exhibitor has their own PayPal account. A surcharge of \$4.00 per transaction must be included. Include PayPal receipt with entry form and mail to Trial Secretary. Submit total entry fee plus \$4.00 surcharge to: [DogObedienceClubofHollywood@gmail.com](mailto:DogObedienceClubofHollywood@gmail.com).

Entry confirmations will be sent via e-mail unless postal mailing is requested.

### **TRANSFERS WILL BE ALLOWED**

The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each Trial. Transfers may be approved provided the next level class and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. Please contact the Trial Secretary for a transfer form and be prepared to supply jump heights for transfer classes.

Day 1 to Day 2 transfers may be done in writing via e-mail if the e-mail contains the necessary information from the applicable transfer form.

### ***PARKING AND ROUTES TO THE SHOW***

**Address for GPS Directions:** 4201 SW 65<sup>th</sup> Way, Davie, FL 33314

**From the West:** Alligator Alley East to I-595, East to Exit 7, Davie Road. South on Davie Road to Main Entrance to the Bergeron Rodeo Grounds on right (SE 43<sup>rd</sup> Street). Main parking lot straight ahead, past the grounds for FastCAT and Frisbee. Please follow parking signs and park in designated areas ONLY. Enter through main gate at north end of parking lot to gain access to Dock diving, Obedience, Rally and Barn Hunt.

**From North/South:** I-95 or Turnpike to I-595 west to Exit 7, Davie Road. Follow directions above.

**MOTOR HOME/RVs:** Complimentary overnight parking will be permitted in the paved parking lot along SE 42<sup>nd</sup> Street (across from the back entrance to the Arena). All units must be self-contained. No electric or water hookups are available. Parking is at your own risk. Please check the “Canine Round Up” Event Page on the DOCOH website for the online registration form available 8/15/2023.

### ***NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS***

Per AKC Regulations, the Trial Secretary is NOT responsible for incorrect or missing information on the entry form. The Trial Secretary may try to obtain missing information but it is not their responsibility to do so. Any additional information must be sent in WRITING through regular mail or via e-mail. If the Class is entered incorrectly by the Secretary, a correction will be made.

Electronic, telephone, or unsigned entries **CANNOT BE ACCEPTED**. Entries must be presented on an official entry form including the signature page on the reverse side. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Entry Fees shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee; or, the Trials cannot be held or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, flood, disaster, Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other event beyond the control of DOCOH.

Full refund can be requested prior to Trial closing date and request must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary (e-mail is acceptable). If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season, and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than one-half hour prior to the start of the first class in the first Trial on Saturday, the full entry fee will be refunded minus \$5.00 for each entry.

The Trial Committee will convene because of any damage to hotel, motel, trial premises or on complaints of abusiveness to judges, stewards, workers, or dogs. All exhibitors are kindly requested to assist in maintaining the cleanliness of the facility and the grounds or hotels. DOCOH assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, visitors, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The welfare of children is the responsibility of the parents or guardian. All damages caused by the exhibitor or the exhibitor’s dogs will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

**THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THESE EVENTS.**

Dogs may **not** arrive prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog not present at the designated class time. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. **INSTRUCTIONS to COMPLETE ENTRY FORM**

- Enter dog's AKC recognized breed. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally Trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog" and enter ILP or PAL registration number. "Breeder, Sire and Dam" information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
- Variety. If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- Consult the classification in this Premium list for Classes Offered. This space may be used to indicate Obedience or Rally Class and the next section for Division (A/B). Consult the rules regarding qualifications for A or B divisions. If entering RAE (adv and exc) or HTQ (adv, exc, mst), please enter B Division. RAE and HTQ fees remain one full entry and reduced entry for second and third class entry of the same dog.
- Full registered name of dog including all AKC recognized titles.
- Eligible dogs include AKC registered purebred, AKC registered PAL (Preferred Alternate Listing)/ILP (Indefinite Listing Privilege), Canine Partners (All-American Dog), FSS (Foundation Stock Service) for dogs aged 6 months or older. - A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed.
